In pursuance of the recommendation of the 32nd Academic Council meeting of the University held on 7th June, 2024 and approval by the 42nd Board of Governors - NU meeting of the University held on 29th July, 2024, I am pleased to inform you about the adoption of "*Policy on Research Excellence Award*" with immediate effect.

POLICY ON RESEARCH EXCELLENCE AWARD

1. Purpose

The purpose of this award is to recognize the research excellence and reward the staff who have demonstrated excellence in their research.

2. Eligibility

Award nominees must have been working as a permanent full-time salaried employee at FAST-NUCES for at least three years at the date nominations close. **The nominee should not have received the same award in last three years**. A detailed eligibility criteria is given in Section 6.

3. Nature of awards

There will be following two awards of PKR. 500,000 each along with their certificates. The University has a right to open a call for either of the two or both awards every year.

- Research Excellence Award (individual)
- Research Excellence Award (team)

4. Nomination process

- 1. Nominations will be called from all the campuses of the university by the Director ORIC and these will be submitted to the ORIC office. Maximum five nominations can be submitted from one campus.
- 2. All nominations should come through the campuses' directors.
- 3. Application form needs to be completed for the nomination to be accepted.

5. Selection Process

- 1. The Application will be evaluated by a committee that will be constituted by ORIC office with the consultation of Higher Authorities.
- 2. The committee will be comprised of ORIC Director (Chair), nominated Dean, and one or three external experts.
- 3. There will be two awards one for each category.
- 4. If no nomination received or criteria is not full filled than no award will be awarded for that category.

6. Award Criteria

6.1. Common criteria for both categories

The Awards for Research Excellence are based on the premise that excellent researchers are inspiring, knowledgeable, enthusiastic, and innovative, with a commitment to their subject FAST-NUCES values, and an ability to generate and communicate new knowledge that contributes to advances and impact in their field of research.

All nominations must explain why each individual or team nominee is considered the top in their field. The researcher must provide his/her **last 3-year achievement/information** etc. Candidates should focus on presenting aspects of their research that include:

- Provide verifiable evidence of achievement.
- List innovative or otherwise noteworthy activities.
- Highlight any research aspect that the candidate believes is particularly remarkable.
- Emphasise any special or strategic interests of FAST-NUCES.
- Indicate research challenges that were overcome.
- Acknowledge other people who have been associated with, supportive of, or influential in, the achievement.
- Show impact on teaching, learning and wider research support at FAST-NUCES.

6.2. Category-wise Criteria

1. Research Excellence Award (Individual)

This award will be given to those who are doing excellent work in the research filed on the base of the following points. Candidates are free to provide whatever evidence they wish to support their case – but specific examples could include:

- High profile publications (HJRS).
- Citations.
- Research fundings both National and International.
- Acknowledgements by the research community e.g., medals, prizes, honorary status.
- National and International achievements.
- Prototype development and product commercialization.
- Service to prestigious Journals e.g., editorial board member, review member.
- Organizer of Conferences/Workshop.
- Keynote/Invited speaker in top ranked conference.
- National and International research collaborations with both academia and industry.
- Impact of research on teaching and learning.
- Consultancy projects.
- Patents/copy right/trademark etc. granted at National/International level.
- Any other supportive document.

2. Research Excellence Award (Team)

This is the University's premier award for a research team and is targeted towards excellence in team research. Nominees are free to provide whatever evidence they wish to support their case but specific examples could include:

- Evidence of interdisciplinary research, which is strongly encouraged.
- Evidence of diversity of research.
- Evidence of a research plan and submitted to different funding bodies/industries.
- Individual contributions to team strategies.
- Novelty or challenges that were tackled.
- Notable achievements, impact or "making a difference".
- Recognition of the team either by grants/Projects or requests for engagement or contribution.
- Impact on students and teaching.
- Contribution to development of the research culture at FAST-NUCES e.g., providing mentorship to the new researchers and students.
- Impact of research on society.
- won national or international awards.
- Collaboration with national/international bodies/organizations.
- Research fundings both National and International.
- Consultancy projects.
- Patents/copy right/trademark etc. Granted (National/International Level).
- Prototype development and product commercialization.
- Any other supportive document.

7. Use of award money

Following guidelines will be observed to use the award money.

- 1. Awardee may receive maximum 50% of the award amount in terms of taxable salary.
- 2. The rest of the award money must be used to cover expenses associated with research activity, knowledge transfer or professional development. More specifically it may be used for the following heads.
 - a. Buying a research equipment.
 - b. Paying journal fee/subscription.
 - c. Attending local conference.

- d. Conference registration.
- e. Local visits (industry/academia).
- f. Dataset collection or preparation.
- g. Any special head with the approval of competent authorities.
- 3. The award must be used in the year following the awards ceremony; no accrual beyond this is permitted.
