Nishan-e-Imtiaz is being conferred on Wasim Sajjad by President Asif Ali Zardari at Aiwan-e-Sadar on March 23, 2011.

Senator, Wasim Sajjad, Leader of Opposition in the Senate of Pakistan, President, FAST and Chancellor of the University has been conferred upon Nishan-e-Imtiaz by the President of Pakistan, Mr.Asif Ali Zardari at a special investiture ceremony held on March 23, 2011 at Aiwan-e-Sadar, Islamabad, in recognition of his services and work on the 18th Amendment to the Constitution and for strengthening democracy and democratic institutions in Pakistan.

Nishan-e-Imtiaz is the highest honor given to any civilian in Pakistan based on the achievements that caused world recognition for Pakistan or/ for an outstanding service for the country.

The Open House provides an opportunity to the industry to interact with the graduating students for the purpose of recruitment for their respective firms/ companies. The students are interviewed and usually evaluated on the basis of their Final Year Projects for possible employment.

Dr. Amir Muhammed, Rector in his address said that essentially this event will give the corporate sector an opportunity to judge abilities and competitiveness of the upcoming generation.

This Open House aims to preserve the talent we have and encourage companies nourish it into professional brilliance, he added.

Dr. Waseem Ikram, Director Islamabad Campus, in his welcome address said that this year the Islamabad Campus is sending around 350 students into the industry. Of these 140 are from BS Computer Science and 90 from BS Telecom Engineering. Graduating batch also includes 60 students from BBA and 50 from MS and MBA.

The presentation was followed by a written test for interested students. 85 students appeared in the test and 60 (25 CS and 35 Telecom) were shortlisted for interview. Interviews by the visiting team were conducted till late evening on May 14, 2011. Before leaving the Campus, Mr. Haroon said that based on the written test interviews of the candidates, the company would decide about their appointment and result to be communicated in about three weeks time.

Only qualified students get scholarships: HEC

As many as 2,045 Pakistanis are currently pursuing their higher education in various foreign universities through the Higher Education Commission (HEC). During the last eight years, a total of 674 students returned to the country after completing PhDs. Most of the students seeking higher education in foreign universities are pursuing their studies in natural sciences including physics, biology, chemistry, engineering and medicine. Other fields include social sciences, business and public administration.

Most of the students selected by the Commission for scholarships hail from developed areas of the country. The Commission has set criteria that students need to meet for scholarships in foreign universities, which is why students mostly from developed areas of the country end up qualifying. The Commission has relaxed its rules to facilitate students from Tribal areas and Balochistan.

BS (EE) student expresses gratitude for grant of loan

M.Bilal Junaid, a student of BS (Electrical Engineering), Department of FAST-NU Islamabad Campus and currently in the last semester of his graduation expressed his deepest gratitude to the FAST-NU Administration for granting him loan for studies.
